



Ulla Billqvists house kept as is, flanked by new neighbours

Church, kept as is

Office building, kept as is

Educational building, kept as is

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Housing tower marks entrance to block M, locale for rent on street level, communicates with tower on block L

New path between central Esbov towards north east

Youth center is kept as it is, building renovated if needed

The circles are intentionally left ground to preserve an air of the industrial landscape

Industrial garage repurposed as restaurant with complementary green house

A park and walking route is established on the inside of the brick wall, along the abandoned train tracks

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Two sheltered lamella buildings defines the courtyard space

House with bent shape gives shelter to the courtyard. The bent shape provides sun on the northern courtyard on morning and evenings

Explore the possibilities of a walking bridge or tunnel to the allotments on the other side of the tracks

New skate park. The pool double as storm water magazine

Second hand store is kept as it is

Allotments are relocated here to broaden the park as a continuation to the apple orchard

Apple orchard is restored with new trees

Industrial building is kept and used to store dismantled resources/building material shop

Former HQ of Slaughterhouse is transformed into apartments

Preserved building transformed into a kindergarten

Row houses forms a small community around the former Slaughterhouse brick building

New passage points for the industrial track

New housing added on top of existing brick buildings

Community green house café built from salvaged materials

Industrial building is kept and transformed into a sports hall with additional volumes

A new primary utilize existing buildings from the timber trade and today's operations

Large scale industrial brick buildings are kept to house grocery store, parking lots and gym
